David Curry Announces Campaign for Tax Commissioner

Will qualify for Republican primary July 15

(McDonough)—Republican David Curry of McDonough is the first to announce his bid to become the next Henry County Tax Commissioner.

“The Tax Commissioner’s office needs the right kind of management to maintain its high level of professionalism,” Curry said. “I am asking for the support of everyone who wants their next commissioner to continue these standards through hard work and dedication to unrivaled service.”

Curry has lived in Henry County for more than 25 years, and researched the operations and procedures of the office after he and current Tax Commissioner Andy Pipkin discussed Pipkin’s retirement. Curry spent several weeks meeting the office staff and Deputy Commissioners before deciding to seek the office.

“The Tax Commissioner’s office is not about setting rates or making policy,” Curry said. “It’s about service, excellence and educating the public about the tax system. I will maintain the commitment to excellence and make sure that every taxpayer understands the system and their rights as taxpayers.”

Curry was a 16-year employee of the Ford Motor Company, a career he started at the age of 18. While at Ford, he became an industrial electrician and later a Skilled Trades Overtime Coordinator, managing the overtime and labor costs of more than 300 tradesmen.

His other professional experience includes service as a Georgia-licensed auctioneer brokering transactions between sellers and buyers and as a certified Realtor focused on commercial and investment properties.

David Curry is a member of the Henry County Chamber of Commerce, Henry County’s Council for Quality Growth and the Leadership Henry’s Class of 2007. He and his wife, Nicole, have four children – Michaela (12), Jacob (10), Kennedy (8) and Caleb (6). The Currys are active members of the Timberridge Presbyterian Church and volunteers with the Connecting Henry Christmas Program.
